B.A./M.A. Shared-Credit Degree Program

Obtain Bachelor's AND Master's degrees in 5 years.

This program allows you to get BOTH undergrad AND grad credit for graduate courses taken in your senior year, saving a full year of study.

PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

at JUNIOR year START

- 3.5 GPA in History
- Contact History Undergrad Advisor (Enrique Sanabria, sanabria@Unm.edu)

by JUNIOR year END

- Complete lower-division History requirements (12 credit hours)
- Complete 4 upper-division History courses, including HIST 491 or 492 with grade of "B" or better
- On track to complete 90 credits by beginning of Senior year
- Apply by February 15 of the Spring semester

APPLICATION PROCESS

A 500-word letter of intent describing your interest in the program and your qualifications.

An unofficial transcript

Two letters of recommendation from History faculty members, who will submit letters directly to the department.

All application materials must be submitted in hard copy by February 15 of junior year to Ms. Dana Ellison, Graduate Secretary.
