

## Assistant Professor Erika Monahan Appears at UNM Bookstore for Book Discussion & Signing

Assistant Professor Erika Monahan will be at the UNM Bookstore on **Wednesday, May 4<sup>th</sup>** at **12:00pm** to sign copies of *The Merchants of Siberia* (Cornell University Press, 2016). This event is open to the public.



In *The Merchants of Siberia: Trade in Early Modern Eurasia*, Monahan examines Russian trade, demonstrating that trade in Siberia from the late sixteenth through eighteenth centuries was more extensive and significant than has been acknowledged heretofore. She follows the history of three Russian families from various social ranks who conducted trade in Siberia for over a century. Monahan informs readers about European trade, merchants, and uses to improve understanding of commercial activity and merchants in Russia. *The Merchants of Siberia* gives readers a revision of the way one imagines the Muscovite economy in
