Frederick G. Bohme Memorial Prize

This award of approximately \$800 is for the best paper on the history of New Mexico and the Southwest. The paper must deal with some aspect of the history of the Southwest from early times to the present, preferably in a way that engages, but need not focus exclusively on, New Mexico history. Candidates for this award may apply directly or be nominated by faculty. To apply or nominate, submit a letter accompanied by **THREE copies of the paper**. The paper must be unpublished, and should be double-spaced. The winning paper will be submitted for publication in the New Mexico Historical Review.
